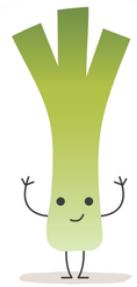


# SPAGHETTI WORMS WITH LLEWELLYN LEEK

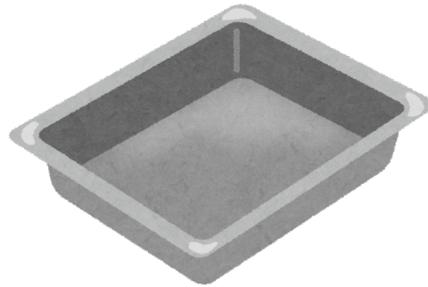


## WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Cooked, cooled spaghetti
- An assortment of toys
- Food colouring, as many different colours as you like
- Small bucket or container
- 3-4 bowls
- Large tray

## BEFORE YOU START:

- Cook and cool spaghetti
- Get your child to collect an assortment of plastic or wipeable toys



## HOW WE DO IT:

1. Place approximately 8 drops of each colour food dye into separate bowls and add even portions of cooked and cooled spaghetti into the bowls.
2. Tip your spaghetti onto a surface to dry. Once dry tip into the bucket or container add the toys – encourage your child to find the toys.
3. If the spaghetti becomes too dry and sticky, have some water handy to squirt onto the pasta to help keep it smooth and slippery to handle.

## LLEWELLYN'S TOP TIPS:

- Get the kids involved by asking them to mix the food colouring with the cooled spaghetti and collect small toys for them to find in their spaghetti worms.
